Trinity Covenant just celebrated our 14<sup>th</sup> anniversary as the first Reformed church in our area. We are about 65 people, ranging from newborns to grandparents. We embrace family-integrated worship, hospitality, and weekly communion. Our congregation enjoys fellowshiping long after the service is over, and we have regular meals together as a church. Few of our people come from a Reformed background, but we share the desire for God's glory to be revealed through Bible-centred worship and life. Trinity Covenant Church is thankful to be a member of the Communion of Reformed Evangelical Churches and enjoys good fellowship with our sister churches.

We are seeking a pastor with a pioneering spirit who can take on the primary role of preaching, administering the sacraments, counseling, teaching, and engaging the local community.
